*** Very Important*** If you did not receive the mail-in ballot application, or have moved, please CONFIRM with the Election Board that you are registered.

Do you know? If you <u>do not</u> fill out your **Census Card**, we will lose \$18, 250 per person over 10 years! Every one of us needs to be counted so we can have the money needed for our children's education, nutrition programs for women, infants and children, money for economic development, school construction, public safety and emergency planning. Time is running out! The deadline to be counted is **September 30, 2020**.

A new "rising star" has joined our family. We are overwhelmed with joy to welcome Ms. Doris Witcher on board.
